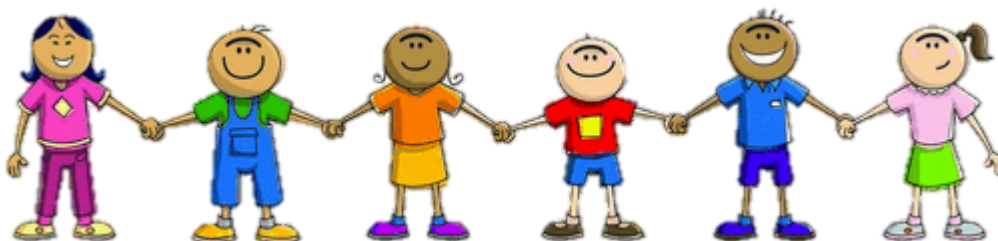

Attendance and Absences

Now more than ever it is important that we are informed early if your child is unwell and will not be at school. This can be done through our skool loop app, email, or a phone call to the office. Please do not contact teachers.

If for some reason your child becomes unwell at school, they will need to be collected immediately. DO NOT send your child to school if they are unwell. Please contact the school office if you need to update emergency contact information .

Hygiene

All classrooms will be provided with hand sanitiser, paper towels, wipes and hand soap in toilets. Children will sanitise on entering and leaving the classroom. Frequently touched surfaces will be disinfected during the day and toilets will be given extra cleans during the day.

Drop off and pick up

Drop off will be from 8.30am. Mrs Anderson will be at the school gate by the hall to ensure everyone sanitises on entry. If possible parents are asked to remain off-site, if parents or visitors enter the school grounds they are encouraged to wear a mask, must report to the office, scan the QR code and sign in. We are operating a 'one in one out' system in the office so please bear with us if the office is busy.

Students travelling by car will need to be dropped off and picked up by the hall. At the end of the day teachers will bring the students over to the school gate to be collected. If possible please stay in your car. If you have grandparents or other family members doing the drop off/pick up, please ensure they are aware of this too.

Buses

Buses will run as normal at level 2. Masks are not required to be worn on school transport however anyone who chooses to can. Masks are recommended for anyone over the age of 12 years. Sourcing is an individual's responsibility.

Kai warmers

Kai warmers will be in operation as normal.

Water Fountains

Water fountains will be unavailable so please ensure your child has a named water bottle. Water only please.

Assembly

There will be no school gatherings during level 2, ie. assembly, kapa haka.
